The Orangefield Junior High Campus is a 64,000 sq. ft. standing seam metal roof. The cost of this roof was \$191,000.00, which included filling the 19" wide x 3" high ribbed roof panels with 3" ESP insulation and 1" ISO insulation over the entire roof. After the new Duro-Last roof was installed, the electrical cost is averaging \$1,987.00 less per month. This means that in eight years the Duro-Last roof has paid for itself and we still have seven (7) years remaining on our 15 year N.D.L. warranty.
