Shreveport, LA

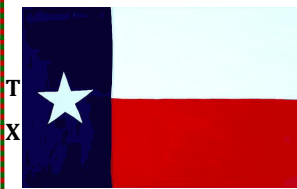
Tower'n Green

Thermography has long been used by governmental and commercial agencies as a means of detecting temperature fluctuations in certain environments and even within certain objects. The same principle applies when measuring temperatures on a roof top using a thermal imaging camera. **Warmer** objects will stand out against those maintaining a **cooler** temperature. With the help of thermal imaging, a **Monument**-installed cool **Duro-Last** roof system is sure to reflect sunlight and minimize **heat** transfer into a building
